Introduction:

There is perhaps no better public indicator (to ourselves and others) of what's in one's heart than one's speech. Our words tend to reflect our hearts.

If someone met you for the first time, spent a week with you, and had nothing else to go by in his/her getting to know you than observing your speech, what would they say about you: words of encouragement or tearing down; words that are positive and hopeful or negative and critical; too many words or too few words?

Read and Discuss:

James 3:1-18

Vv 1-12:

- 1. Put into your own words how James likens horse bits, ship rudders, and small fires, to the tongue. What is his main point here?
- 2. In what sense is the tongue difficult to "tame"?

- 3. What is James's main point in vv. 9-12?
- 4. How helpful is it for you for James to speak of the tongue as a 'thing' in itself, rather than simply discussing our words and speech?
- 5. Why do you think our speech is so important to our spiritual maturity?

Vv. 13-18:

- 1. How does James describe those who live in a wise, godly way versus those who don't? (List the different adjectives that are mentioned for the two different lifestyles.) What are the consequences of both kinds of lifestyles?
- 2. Would you say you are generally more meek, wise, peaceable, gentle, reasonable, merciful, impartial and sincere...or bitterly jealous, with selfish ambition?

Application

- 1. What kinds of things, practically, can we do to improve the way our tongue works?
- 2. How much actual control do we have over our tongues/speech?
